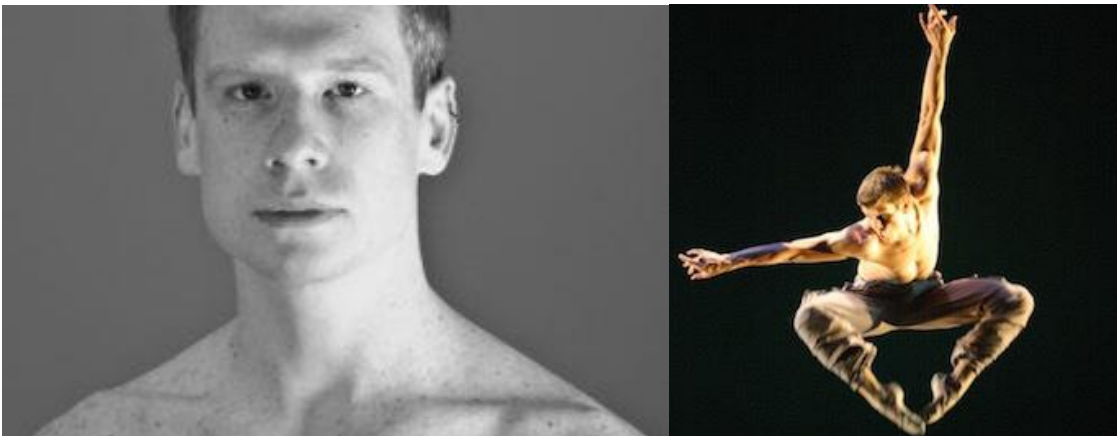

Dr. Leslie D. Netting retired Professor Emeritus after 27 years as a Full Professor and Director of Dance at Kutztown University, received her undergraduate degree in Early Childhood/Elementary Ed. from Boston College, her Masters Degree in Physical Education and Dance from Adelphi University, and her Doctoral Degree in Dance Education and Higher Administration from New York University. Dr. Netting's extensive study in contemporary and lyrical jazz dance and her tutelage under Alvin Ailey, Matt Mattox, Luigi, and Lynn Simonson brought about her selection as Scholar in Residence at Kenyatta University in Kenya, Africa. During her stay in Africa, Dr. Netting taught dance technique and theory, as well as, documented tribal performance in its natural habitat. Dr. Netting was also selected to present a workshop on teaching of lyrical jazz dance at the secondary level at the prestigious International Conference of Dance and the Child held in Kuopio, Finland, at the AAHPERD National Conventions in Reno, Nevada, and in Orlando, Florida. Additionally, Dr. Netting was invited to speak and share her teaching expertise in Lisbon, Portugal and at the New Trends In Dance Conference in Mexico. One of Dr. Netting's greatest achievements was being selected as Scholar in Residence at Yantai University in China. In addition to educating Chinese students in American Dance forms, she choreographed and performed for 40,000 people at Yantai's 20th Anniversary Celebration. Dr. Netting has also been recognized for her expertise in lyrical jazz dance at the 18th World Congress in Dance Research that was held in Athens, Greece. Most recently Dr. Netting was honored to be invited to a master class and choreographic reconstruction by both Twyla Tharp and Judith Jamison in two different events held at the Wallis Annenberg Center for the Performing Arts in Los Angeles, CA.

Daniel Mayo is originally from Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. He received his BFA in Dance in 2007 from The Juilliard School in New York City. Daniel currently dances with the Philadelphia based company BalletX, with which he has been a company member since 2014. With BalletX, Daniel has performed extensively throughout the United States, and has performed in numerous creations including works by choreographers Matthew Neenan, Jorma Elo, Nicolo Fonte, and Trey McIntyre. Before joining BalletX, Daniel was a member of the Montreal based company RUBBERBANDance Group under the direction of Victor Quijada. During his 3 years with RUBBERBANDance Group, Daniel toured throughout North America, Europe, and Asia, and participated in multiple film projects, most notably for Bravo!FACT. From 2007-2010 Daniel was a company dancer with Atlanta Ballet under the direction of John McFall, where he performed many classical roles as well as contemporary works. He has also worked professionally as a guest artist with The Atlanta Opera, Dance Grand Moultrie, and Bennyroyce Dance. Daniel was on faculty at Western Wyoming Community College, and serves as a guest teacher and choreographer throughout the United States.

Steven Vaughn was born in the Midwest and raised in Massachusetts. He graduated with Honors from the University of the Arts in Philadelphia, PA in 2009, earning a BFA in Modern Dance, focusing on choreography. Steve has been a dancer with Parsons Dance (under David Parsons) since 2008 touring extensively domestically and internationally, including Italy, China, Brazil, Russia, and more. With Parsons, he worked with Monica Bill-Barnes, Kate Skarpetowska, and Robert Battle. He has taught throughout the United States including various dance college programs and the Broadway Dance Center and Joffrey School, as well as, masterclasses in Italy and Israel. His choreography has been set on the Philadelphia based SHARP Dance Co. under director Diane Sharp- Nachsin, and was selected for the 2014 Emerging Choreographer Commission for Houston Metropolitan Dance Company. Steve is featured twice in Jordan Matter's New York Times Bestseller, "Dancers Among Us" and TV and film experiences include Teddy Forance and Jon Arpino's dance documentary "Movement One" starring Stephen "tWitch" Boss, "Operatic Heat: Parsons Dance presents 'Remember Me'", "All the Right Moves", the feature film "Now You See Me" and "Law and Order: SVU".
